Adding Read Only Google Calendar to your devices:

Android Phones and Tablets - It is my understanding that all Android devices are typically linked to a Google Gmail account. If you have not done that yet, start with these instructions:

To make the calendar visible:

On a standard computer browser, log into Google with your account number

1. Open Google Calendars from the header.
2. On the left side there is a section call "Other Calendars", expand that by clicking the little arrow to the left of the words, if it is not all ready expanded.
3. In the box that says, "Add a Friend's Calendar" type AZTROOP278.
4. Look to see that a calendar called Troop 278 now appears below the header.
5. Open the accounts application as described above.
6. Select option to sync calendars.
7. Look for Troop 278 Calendar and make sure it is enabled to for auto syncing.

Apple iPads and iPhones with IOS5:

To add the calendar:

1. Open the Settings application.
2. Select Mail, Contact, and Calendars from the left pane.
3. Click on add account.
4. Select the "other" account type.
5. Select Add Subscribed Calendar from the list.
6. Enter the following URL as the Server:

Click next and allow it to verify the calendar.
Click next to save without entering any additional information.
Open the Calendar application.
Validate that the Troop 278 Calendar appears in the list.
